In choosing to study a Modern Language alongside English Language and Linguistics students will greatly enhance their communication skills and gain the experience necessary for a successful career in a wide range of exciting professions. Modern Language studies will focus on developing excellent verbal and written communication skills in a chosen language while exploring the society and culture of the countries where the language is spoken. In English Language and Linguistics, students learn about language structure (syntax, phonetics and phonology, morphology) and how language varies according to user and context. In Contrastive Linguistics, our students explore the similarities and differences between their chosen Modern language, English and other world grammars. Alongside an exciting range of module choices, relating to language acquisition and change, language and gender, media and political discourse, forensic linguistics, literary linguistics and psycholinguistics, there is an integrated programme of study aimed at enhancing proficiency in written English.

All students will have access to our Worldwise Learning Centre, which is open year-round and offers advice and support for the study of world languages and cultures, travelling, and working or studying abroad. It also provides a comfortable place to meet and make friends with speakers of different languages in a welcoming environment. Students can learn about opportunities to apply for a travel bursary for studying or working abroad, apply for short-term internships and work experience placements and attend culture and language celebration events, shows, exhibitions and guest talks by industry professionals with international experience.
