ALL STUDENTS WILL HAVE ACCESS TO OUR WORLDWIDE LEARNING CENTRE, WHICH IS OPEN YEAR-ROUND AND OFFERS ADVICE AND SUPPORT FOR THE STUDY OF WORLD LANGUAGES AND CULTURES, TRAVELLING, AND WORKING OR STUDYING ABROAD.

Whether students are a beginner or have an A Level in their chosen language, they will find the combination of a foreign language and teaching English a stimulating and career enhancing degree option. Our students develop fluency in their chosen language and gain a thorough understanding of the wider social, cultural and political context of the regions where their chosen language is spoken.

The course develops confidence, organisational, analytical and people skills along with cultural awareness and aims to consolidate and strengthen their existing knowledge of grammar and expression. Utilising links we have with national and international employers, we provide students with opportunities to gain valuable work experience throughout their studies.

Alongside language studies, students will analyse the theories, approaches and methodologies related to teaching and learning English. Our TESOL provision is accredited by Trinity College. At the end of the second year students have the opportunity to be awarded the Trinity Cert TESOL. This internationally recognised professional qualification will allow our students to start teaching soon after.
